Objective

The visit aimed to familiarize students with the functioning of a police station and its role in medico-legal cases, highlighting practical aspects of forensic medicine and legal procedures.

Key Activities

Introduction to Police Station Operations:

Students were briefed on the organization and working of various departments within the police station. Senior Police Inspector Mr. Madhukar Kad explained the registration process for First Information Reports (FIRs) and the maintenance of police records.

Medico-Legal Documentation:

Demonstrations were given on the preparation of medico-legal reports and their significance in legal proceedings. A detailed explanation of the chain of custody and evidence handling was provided.

Tour of Facilities:

Students visited the evidence storage room, detention area, and other critical facilities. The role of forensic experts in assisting the police during investigations was discussed.

Firearms Demonstration:

A police constable, as instructed by Senior Police Inspector Mr. Madhukar Kad, demonstrated various firearm weapons. Students learned about firearm handling, safety measures, and the legalities associated with their use in law enforcement.

Working of the Crime Detection Centre:

The functioning of the Crime Detection Centre was explained to students. They were introduced to techniques used in forensic investigations, including fingerprint analysis, document verification, and evidence processing.

Interactive Session:

An interactive Q&A session was held, during which all queries were answered patiently and in detail by Senior Police Inspector Mr. Madhukar Kad and his team.

Learning Outcomes

- Gained insight into police procedures relevant to forensic medicine.
- Understood the importance of medico-legal documentation and ethical practices.
- Observed real-world applications of FMT in the criminal justice system.
- Acquired basic knowledge about firearms, their mechanisms, and their role in police operations.
- Learned about the essential techniques used in crime detection and forensic investigation.
- Appreciated the detailed and patient explanations provided during the interactive session.

The visit was educational and enriched students' practical understanding of the interface between forensic medicine and law enforcement.
