Objective of the Court Visit

The primary objective of the District Court visit was to provide 2nd BHMS students with practical exposure to the judicial system and to:

- Understand the functioning and structure of civil & criminal courts.
- Observe real-time courtroom proceedings, including the roles of judges, advocates, and witnesses.
- Recognize the medico-legal responsibilities of doctors within the legal system.
- Gain awareness of courtroom decorum, legal terminologies, and trial procedures.
- Bridge the gap between theoretical learning in Forensic Medicine and its real-life applications.

Purpose of Visit:

The educational visit to the District Court, Nashik was organized as part of the academic curriculum of the Forensic Medicine and Toxicology (FMT) Department to provide students with firsthand exposure to judicial processes and courtroom proceedings.

Details of Visit:

A total of 47 students were divided into five groups, each group assigned to observe proceedings in different criminal courts. Students observed various stages of criminal trials including examination of witnesses, cross-examination, framing of charges, arguments, and delivery of court orders. This arrangement ensured wide coverage of courtroom procedures and allowed each group to gain varied experiences.

Learning Outcomes:

- Understanding of the structure and functioning of criminal courts.
- Familiarity with court decorum and procedural aspects.



- Insight into the medico-legal role of doctors, particularly as expert witnesses.
