Purpose of Visit	To provide practical exposure to police procedures and medico-legal investigations as prescribed under the CBDC curriculum of the National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH).
Objective of visit	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To familiarize students with the organization and functioning of a Police Station.• To understand the role of police in medico-legal investigations and administration of justice.• To study the procedure of registration of complaints, FIRs, and medico-legal cases.• To observe the process of inquest, panchnama, evidence collection, and record maintenance.• To understand the coordination between police authorities and medical professionals in medico-legal matters.• To provide practical exposure and experiential learning in Forensic Medicine and Toxicology as per the CBDC curriculum.
Arrival and Reception	Students and faculty members were welcomed by the police officials of Ambad Police Station and briefed about the objectives and schedule of the visit.
Introduction to Police Administration	The Police Inspector explained the organizational structure, hierarchy, and day-to-day functioning of the Police Department.
Registration of Complaints and FIR & Medico-Legal Case Procedures	An interactive guidance session was conducted by Senior Police Inspector Mr. Rajput Sir, who elaborated on the legal and procedural aspects of First Information Reports (FIRs), Medico-Legal Cases (MLCs), and Dying Declarations. He explained the significance of these documents in criminal investigations and judicial proceedings and highlighted the crucial role of medical professionals in medico-legal cases. The session helped students understand the coordination required between healthcare providers and law enforcement agencies during the investigation of accidents, assaults, poisoning cases, and

	<p>other medico-legal matters.</p> <p>Students learned about crime scene investigation, evidence collection, witness examination, and documentation procedures.</p>
Demonstration of firearms and cartridges	A special attraction of the visit was the firearm demonstration conducted by Inspector Sachin Jadhav. He introduced the students to various firearms used by the police department and explained their mechanism, safety measures, handling procedures, and medico-legal relevance. The demonstration provided valuable knowledge regarding firearm injuries, ballistic evidence, and their importance in forensic investigations. The students actively participated throughout the visit, raising queries and engaging in meaningful discussions with the police officials.
Inquest and Panchnama	Police officials explained inquest proceedings, spot panchnama, seizure panchnama, and their medico-legal significance.
Maintenance of Records	Demonstration of FIR registers, station diaries, arrest records, and case documentation was conducted.
Role of Police in Unnatural Deaths	Procedures followed during investigation of accidental, suicidal, and homicidal deaths were discussed.
Interactive Session	Students interacted with police officers and clarified their doubts regarding medico-legal investigations and legal responsibilities of medical practitioners.
Outcome of the Visit	The visit enhanced understanding of forensic medicine concepts and their practical application in legal and criminal investigations.
Conclusion	The visit was highly informative and educational. It successfully fulfilled the objectives of the CBDC curriculum and contributed to experiential learning in Forensic Medicine & Toxicology.
